Our lab is an initiative to explore the minds of the youths and inculcate in them the practical aspects of academics to match with the technologies of the present league of education, shortening the gap of learning and providing the means for them to learn how to share, reuse and reproduce new ideas in a co-ordinated and innovative way resulting in a global way of learning science.*



## **SMART CLASSROOM**

*The idea of the smart class is a complementary feature of educational environment of the school. Since its inception, teaching has acquired new significance as it instils curiosity and generates interest among students. We use all interactive modules in smart class along with accessories like videos, document camera, projector, presentations etc. and these visually attractive methods of live teaching becomes appealing to students who are already struggling with the traditional manner of teaching in a classroom. Smart boards have all information memory and can be presented during class hours with video animations etc. to stimulate time to attend to other important areas of teaching-learning and to make the curriculum interesting. 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## COMPUTER LAB

*In the wake of the phenomenon of information technology sweeping across all borders, the college has also ensured a well-equipped and innovative computer laboratory to minimize the void between students hailing from different backgrounds. The computer lab of Ajmal Senior Secondary School, Hojai is open for students and teachers alike to enable better adaptation of the upcoming generation with the all pervading changes. The Computer lab is instituted in accordance with the AHSEC guidelines to benefit the student community by moulding them into techno-savvy individuals.*



## DISCIPLINE INSIDE THE CAMPUS

*The school is very firm on its rules & discipline. The important norms of discipline are:*

- 1. Students should speak English in the school campus.*
- 2. Every student must wear the school uniform, carry School Identity Card and attend all classes regularly.*
- 3. Students with less than 85% attendance in an academic year will not be allowed to sit for the final examination.*
- 4. Irregularity in attendance, commission of gross misconduct, adoption of unfair means in the examinations, serious violation of discipline, indulgence in ragging and resorting to violence, class bunking etc. may call for punishment as severe as expulsion from the college.*
- 5. No student is allowed to leave the college premises during the class hours without prior permission from the appropriate authority.*
- 6. Defacing, devaluing or any damage to college property will have to be appropriately compensated.*
- 7. Fee once paid will not be refunded in case any student voluntarily leaves the school after taking admission.*

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## EXAMINATIONS

Besides the final Examination conducted by the AHSEC, we conduct Weekly Tests, Unit Tests, Pre-Final Exam I and Pre-Final Exam II. The performance in these tests will determine whether the student should be allowed to sit for the final examination. After each test/examination, the Progress Card will be sent to the guardian and the necessary follow-up actions will be undertaken.

### • SPORTS CLUB

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## HOSTEL

The college provides excellent hostel facilities, spacious room with proper bathroom and toilet facilities. Students are under constant guidance and care within the hostel campus. The students are inculcated with discipline, manners and punctuality without encroaching upon their freedom. Mental conditioning and physical development are made through routine painting & debate competitions. Students are encouraged to exhibit their skills as well as develop their leadership qualities by shedding off inhibitions and hesitation. Moreover, the school/hostel also conducts motivational sessions for the students, where dignitaries from diverse fields of national and international recognition are invited on a regular basis. The environment of the hostel ensures an aesthetic as well as moral uplift to the students.



## COMPETITIONS

Synchronizing with the celebration of Republic Day and Independence Day, Ajmal Foundation conducts quiz programmes among all the colleges under its aegis. Cultural and sport events are also conducted synchronizing with admission of new batch of students into the H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> year. 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# ADMISSION GUIDELINES

## PROCEDURE

*Admission is based strictly on merit and the admission procedure is formulated by the School Governing Body and the Academic Committee, keeping in view the guidelines issued by the Government from time to time.*

- 1. Candidates who wish to take admission into Arts, Commerce & Science streams must have scores of at least 60%, 65% & 75% marks respectively in the last HSLC or equivalent Examination.*
- 2. Admission to H.S. First Year of the School starts following the declaration of HSLC Examination result by the Board of Secondary Education Assam. Admissions are given strictly as per the guidelines issued by the Department of Education, Govt. of Assam and as per the policies framed by the management of the college from time to time.*
- 3. Those seeking admission in Class IX must produce marks sheets and certificates testifying their passing of Class VIII annual examination. This will be followed by a screening test which the candidates will have to qualify.*
- 4. The candidates who have passed the HSLC Examination of the Board of Secondary Education Assam (SEBA) or an examination regarded as equivalent by SEBA are eligible for admission into H.S. 1st Year class.*
- 5. Application for admission must also be separately submitted in the prescribed hard form.*
- 6. Candidates who wish to apply to different streams must apply in separate application forms.*
- 7. Hard copy of admission form is available along with the prospectus.*
- 8. The duly filled in application form has to be submitted in the School office as per the admission schedule published on the Notice Board.*
- 9. The list of provisionally selected candidates will be published on the School Notice Board. The candidate along with his parents must appear with original testimonials for interview and counseling as per appointed date and time.*
- 10. Reserved category (SC/ST/OBCs) and physically disabled students must produce the original caste/category/disability certificate issued by the concerned authorities, and a photocopy of the same must be submitted along with the application form.*
- 11. Students successfully passing the 1st Year examination will be admitted to the 2nd year: Fresh admission into the 2nd Year is allowed to those who have obtained permission from the ASSEB, (Div-II) provided the School authority is convinced about the reason(s) for the transfer.*

- 2. Fees must be paid in four installments each within the due dates.*
- 3. Delay in payment of fees within stipulated dates will lead to imposition of fines.*
- 4. The tuition fees and other fees may be revised from time to time.*

## TRANSFER RULES

1. The guardian will have to apply to the Principal stating reasons for transfer from the college.

3. Rs. 100/- will be charged as processing fee for the Transfer Certificate.
